## **Shuster Secures \$3.8 Million for Raystown Lake**

### ***Operations and Maintenance Funding Placed in Soon to be Passed Energy and Water Bill***

*Washington, D.C.* – **Congressman Bill Shuster** is pleased to announce that he has successfully secured \$3.8 million in the House Energy and Water Appropriations Bill for Raystown Lake. The legislation is scheduled for a vote by the House this week.

“I am pleased that the Energy and Water bill will come to the House floor this week with my request for Raystown Lake intact,” Shuster said.

“Raystown Lake has always been and continues to be a priority of mine in Huntingdon County. This funding will enable residents of central and western Pennsylvania to continue to enjoy the wonderful natural experiences the lake has to offer.”

Congressman Shuster worked with his colleagues in both parties to secure this important funding for Raystown Lake. House passage of the Energy and Water Appropriations Bill is only one part in the process. The Senate must pass their own version of the bill. Congressman Shuster is looking forward to working with Senators Specter and Casey as they work on funding levels in the Senate.
